

MPs Vote on Assisted Dying Bill



MPs voted for the Assisted Dying Bill. It helps very sick adults in England and Wales end their lives. It still needs checking by the House of Lords.



Some changes to protect disabled people were not accepted. Groups worry about the Bill's impact and wrote a letter to share their concerns.



The Royal College of Psychiatrists says the Bill is unclear. People with learning disabilities may not understand dying. Not enough experts to help.
