



A young woman in Cardiff died from sepsis, pneumonia, and Crohn's disease. Her health got worse quickly, and doctors couldn't save her.



An expert said Bethan might have been saved if treated sooner in the resuscitation area.



Bethan got fluids and medicine, but doctors couldn't stop the viral sepsis. There were no drugs for viral sepsis then.



The inquest will go on. The coroner will share their findings later. Bethan's case shows the need for quick help with fast illnesses.
