

Koi herpesvirus is a fish disease. It causes white gills and sunken eyes. Report it to Fish Health Inspectorate if you see these signs.



The FHI checks places with KHV to stop it spreading. They control fish movement there. You need FHI permission to make changes at these sites.



KHV is a fish disease in the UK. To manage it, tests are done, cleaning is needed, fish movement is stopped, and sometimes fish are removed.
