



The UK government shared its plan on spending for schools, the NHS, and transport for the next three years.



Schools in England will get more money to fix old buildings, provide free meals, and help children with special needs, but more is needed.



The NHS will get more money for staff, medicine, and care. But with more people needing help, it's not clear if it's enough.



There is money for new trains and buses. Bus fares will stay low. Changes might not happen until the 2030s.



More money for housing, police, and prisons. New homes and more funds for police. Prisons get money to fix overcrowding, but building takes time.
