

The Forestry Commission warns about a bug called lps typographus. It can harm spruce trees. The risk is high due to the warm, dry spring. Be careful.



The bug can harm trees. The Forestry Commission has a plan to stop it.



Report bug sightings. Follow rules about moving spruce trees. Some trees must be cut to stop the bug from spreading.



Help is available to remove trees in risky areas. Workshops and studies are finding better ways to manage bugs. Quick action is important.
