



The UN Ocean Conference in France saw nearly 200 countries agree to protect the ocean, addressing plastic pollution and illegal fishing.



50 countries now agree to protect 30% of the ocean. More will join soon. Countries are working together to help the ocean.



The UK plans to stop bottom trawling in some places. This fishing harms sea life. More countries are making their waters safe for ocean animals.



Some countries want to pause deep sea mining. Only 37 agreed. Many think more research is needed before starting.



Plastic in the sea is a big problem. Ministers from 97 countries want a plan to cut plastic and protect sea life.



Poorer countries want more help and faster money from richer ones to fight climate change. The ocean takes in a lot of heat, which is important.
