



The Spending Review will change money use in the UK from 2026. It affects jobs, meals, fuel, transport, services, energy bills, and housing.



Jobs in the NHS and defence might grow. New projects like Sizewell C could create jobs, but it will take time.



From 2026, children in England whose parents get universal credit can have free school meals. Rules differ in Scotland, Wales, and Northern Ireland.



Winter fuel payments help pensioners with heating. Now given to those earning £35,000 or less. Government decided not to cut it.
