The government said staff could quit if they disagreed with its actions. Some staff were angry as they want to speak up without leaving their jobs.

The government stopped selling some weapons to Israel and warned them to stop attacks. Some think the government should do more to help.



The Foreign Office says staff can share worries and meet to discuss them. They want the government to listen and act on their concerns.
