



The UK is giving £6 billion to the NHS for 4 million more tests, new scanners, and to help hospitals work better in 5 years.



92% of patients will get treatment in 18 weeks. More ambulances and centres will be built for care close to home.



The government will spend £30 billion to fix NHS buildings so doctors can help people better and faster.



More mental health staff and school support. By 2028, £4 billion more yearly for adult social care to improve care.
