



Women's Super League had 10% fewer fans at games last season compared to the one before.



Bristol City left the league. They had many fans. Crystal Palace replaced them but had fewer people at their games.



Big clubs like Arsenal, Aston Villa, and Manchester United had fewer fans. Aston Villa and Manchester United lost 33% of their fans.



Liverpool had 54% more fans, and Tottenham had 24% more fans watching their games.



Lionesses' success boosted WSL crowds. Last season, no big event might have affected fan numbers.



The WSL is looking at ways to bring more fans to games. This includes thinking about when matches start and how clubs connect with their communities.
