The travel ban affects Afghans. Some go to Pakistan to wait. Others, like Samira, don't know what to do. Going back to Afghanistan is not safe.



Some Afghans who worked with the US military have reached the US. Mojo's sister is still hiding in Afghanistan, waiting for a decision.



The ban worries Zarifa, an Afghan in the US, about travelling to Germany. It's stressful for her and her child.



Many feel the ban breaks a promise to Afghans who helped. Some Afghans have other problems, like not enough food, and feel forgotten.
