

Nurses in England, Wales, and Northern Ireland will vote on a 3.6% pay rise. The RCN calls it "grotesque." This may lead to more strikes.



Doctors got a 5.4% rise, senior doctors 4%, and nurses 3.6%. Nurses feel valued but leave due to low pay.



The Scottish government agreed to an 8% pay rise over two years. Other health unions are voting on pay too. This could affect NHS plans in England.
