



Muhammed Asif Hafeez was a businessman in London who met important people and said he helped stop drug shipments out of duty.



Hafeez was a big drug dealer in the UK, selling drugs worldwide. He informed on rival gangs and was called "the Sultan."



Hafeez was sent to the US in 2023 for drug charges. He got 16 years in a New York prison.

Hafeez pretended to be a worried citizen in letters. But it was a trick. A secret 2014 meeting filmed by US agents led to his downfall.

In 2019, Hafeez's friends admitted guilt in the US. Hafeez tried to avoid extradition due to health concerns but failed. He pleaded guilty in 2023.
