

The UK will give more money to help 9 million pensioners with energy bills this winter.



Up to £300 for under 80s, £200 for over 80s, to help with heating. Two sharing split the money. No payment if one earns over £35,000.



The government says no more borrowing. Some worry about costs. Charities want more help for those who struggle with energy bills.



In Scotland and Northern Ireland, pension help may change. The government will share spending plans soon. There might be cuts in other areas.
