



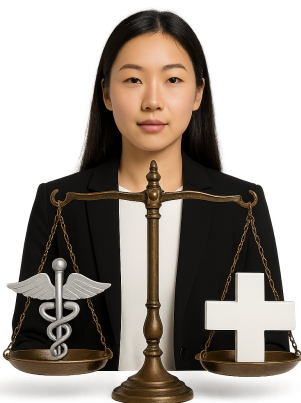
Martha Mills died from sepsis in 2021 after a bike accident. A doctor didn't give her needed care. The tribunal called it "gross negligence."
