

Changes to Asylum Rules in the UK



The UK wants asylum seekers to stay for 30 months, not forever, to encourage them to return home if things improve.



The government may give less money to asylum seekers who can work. Families who can't stay might lose support, but children will be cared for.



The plan is to make decisions faster, respect family rights, follow human rights, stop misuse, fix past problems, and help those in need.
