



Trump's plan gives \$1,000 to new US babies to invest in stocks. It cuts help for poor people.



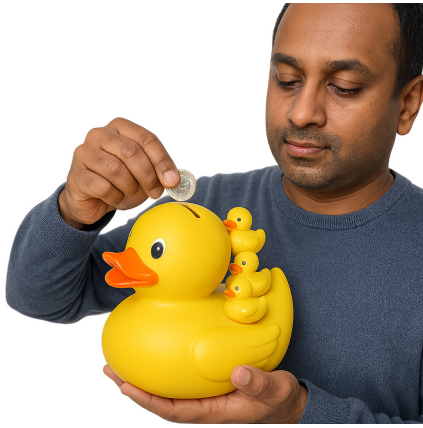
The UK had a Child Trust Fund to help kids save money, but it was stopped.
