



A mum is upset because a review about her daughter's death took too long. Her daughter was killed by her ex in 2019. The review was to stop this happening again.



Police missed chances to arrest the killer. The review took nearly three years, not six months, causing distress for Bethany's mum.



Many families feel the same. Few reviews are on time. Many take years, which is too long for families waiting for answers.



The government wants to make things faster. They will start a new group to help. Some think reviews are important to show what happens in domestic abuse cases.



Advocacy After Fatal Domestic Abuse helps families. They say reviews give important info on abuse but think the process could improve.



Families want answers and changes to stop deaths. Reviews take too long and don't help enough. The government is trying, but families still wait.
