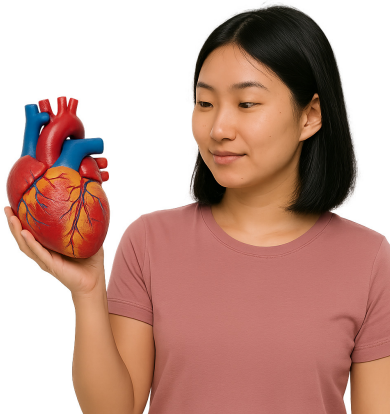




A book called "The Safekeep" by Yael van der Wouden won a prize. It tells a love story between two women in the Netherlands in the 1960s.
