

There are more measles cases in England. Most are in children under 10 who haven't had the vaccine.



Measles is spreading. Check if you need the MMR vaccine before travelling for holidays.



The MMR vaccine stops measles, mumps, and rubella. Babies get it at 1 year and again at 3 years 4 months. You can get it later if you missed it.



Measles spreads fast and can make you very ill. Babies and some people can't have the vaccine. Getting vaccinated helps keep everyone safe.



Check if you need the vaccine if you work with kids, go to college, or plan to travel. Ask your doctor or check your health records.
