



The National Trust covered JK Rowling's name on an artwork at Hardwick Hall after it was changed. Someone removed the cover last week.



Visitors were asked not to change the art. It was taken off display to check damage. The artwork had names like Rosa Parks, Taylor Swift, and "mum".



Some disagree with Rowling's gender views. A campaigner called the stitching "hateful." The Trust said the views are from participants, not them.
