The court said the hospital and manager did not stop Alice from getting hurt. Her family warned about dangers, but no one listened.



Alice's family said she was smart and funny. She was sad since she was a teen and had eating problems. They wanted the hospital to improve care.

Alice's family wants justice and safety for others.



The hospital was not charged with corporate manslaughter. People will watch this case to learn how to improve mental health care.
