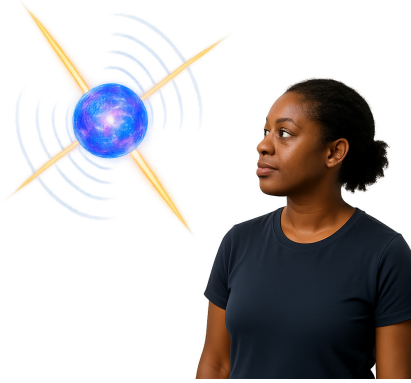
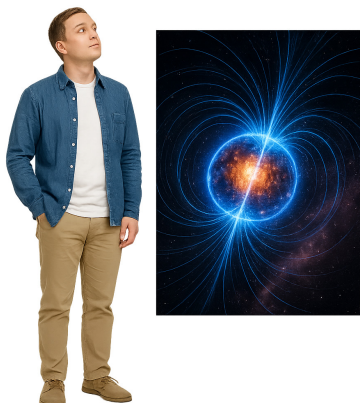




Scientists found a star, ASKAP J1832, 15,000 light years away. It pulses every 44 minutes with radio waves and X-rays, which is unusual.
