



An art expert was jailed for selling art to a man linked to a banned group, breaking the Terrorism Act 2000.



Ojiri sold art to Nazem Ahmad, linked to Hezbollah. Ahmad used art to hide money. Police found Ojiri knew but still sold him art.



Police found Ojiri was paid for art sent to Dubai and Beirut. New rules helped catch him.



Police took art worth nearly £1 million linked to Ahmad. It will be sold to help fight crime. Ojiri apologised, saying he wanted to grow his business.
