

Health Checks Help People in Sussex



In Sussex, more people with learning disabilities and severe mental illness get free health checks. Sussex is doing better than national goals.



Over 8,000 people with learning disabilities got their checks last year. This is 77% of those who should have had them. People with severe mental.



Checks look at blood pressure and weight to stop health problems. People 14+ on the learning disability register can get checks. Contact your GP.
