



The UK Government will help victims of rape. A new plan lets victims ask for another prosecutor if their case might be dropped.



A pilot in the West Midlands helps victims trust the justice system. If enough evidence is found, the case continues, making victims feel heard.



The Government wants less violence against women and girls. They are improving the justice system for victims. This is part of their Plan for Change.



Victims can ask for a review if a case stops. A six-month pilot will test this.



The test is for some cases and will be checked. If it works, it might be used in the UK. The Government wants victims to feel safe and supported.
