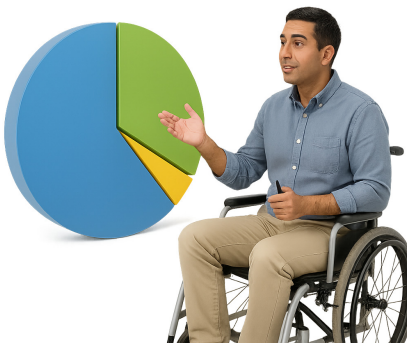




The Spending Review decides money for the NHS, schools, and police. It affects everyone and shows the government is fixing things.
