



Eurostar will have direct trains from London to Frankfurt and Geneva by the early 2030s. The trip will take about five hours.



More people want to travel by train in Europe. New routes from Amsterdam and Brussels to Geneva are planned. Stops are not yet clear.



In 2024, Eurostar had 19.5 million passengers, up 5% from 2023. They will run more trains from London to Paris through the Channel Tunnel.
