



Changes to UK Asylum Rules



The UK wants fewer people on small boats. They plan to deport faster and change rules for who can stay.



People can only appeal once if told to leave. If they lose, they go back. It will be harder to use human rights laws to stay in the UK.



People can stay for a short time. They must wait 20 years to apply to stay forever. The government says this is to keep the country safe and fair.
