



Six people were sent away from Israel for trying to break Gaza's blockade. They were on a boat stopped by Israeli forces. Two will leave soon.



The group wanted to help Gaza with baby formula and medicine. Israel said aid would go another way. The trip showed Gaza's problems.



Activists felt treated badly in Israel. Adalah helped them return safely. Israel said breaking the blockade was illegal and unsafe.



Israel stopped aid to Gaza, causing food shortages. Later, some food was allowed in, but only through certain groups. The UN does not agree.
