

An Australian woman, Erin Patterson, is on trial for murder. She is accused of poisoning her relatives with toxic mushrooms in a beef Wellington dish.



Erin's in-laws and Gail's sister got very sick and died after lunch. The trial is to see if Erin is guilty.



Prosecutors say Erin used scales to measure harmful mushrooms. This may show she planned to hurt them.
