The review is about two types of spending: daily costs like salaries and supplies, and investment in building schools and roads. It covers 3-4 years.



Some areas might get more money. NHS, defence, free school meals, public transport, and science may see increases.



The government may build a new nuclear power station in Suffolk and small ones in England and Wales, needing money from the government and investors.



The UK economy is growing. The government is careful with money to avoid too much borrowing. They have rules to reduce debt over time.
