

A court said President Trump couldn't use a special law to add extra taxes on things from Canada, Mexico, and China to stop the drug fentanyl.



The court stopped a new 10% tax on goods into the US, but not Trump's 25% tax on steel, aluminium, cars, and parts.



The court's decision may affect US tax money. Some taxes made a lot, but stopped ones were expected to make even more.



Trump used taxes for deals. Now, countries like the European Union might wait before making deals with the US.



The court's decision may help trade, but there is still uncertainty. Trump might use other laws to bring back taxes, affecting global trade.
