Australia follows nuclear rules with the IAEA since 2023 to ensure safety and legality.

Australia will get nuclear fuel safely in sealed units, only for submarines.



AUKUS follows the NPT rules. The UK and US will help Australia but won't give them nuclear weapons.



Some people have questions about this plan. AUKUS partners talk openly to help everyone understand and feel safe. They want to do everything right.



AUKUS partners promise to care for the environment. They use nuclear power safely and will handle waste properly.



The plan is also about building new skills and jobs in Australia. This will help them take care of the submarines by themselves in the future.



AUKUS partners will update everyone. They will share info with IAEA and other countries to show they follow the rules.



AUKUS plans to use nuclear power safely for people and the environment. They are working hard to do it right.

AUKUS partners will keep sharing what they do and why. They will answer questions and share information.
