



Cleaning Up Chewing Gum



The UK is giving over £1 million to 52 councils to clean chewing gum stains. Councils like Glasgow and Cardiff will get help to clean streets.



Gum companies help councils clean streets and teach people to bin gum. This started in 2021 to stop littering and make towns nicer.



Chewing gum litter is messy and costly. The Chewing Gum Task Force has given £4.88 million to 122 councils and cleaned 3.4 million square metres.
