

The UK has stopped unfair bonuses for bosses at six water companies because they didn't meet standards.



The Water Act stops bonuses for bosses if their company pollutes or doesn't care for customers.



Water bosses got over £112 million in bonuses in 10 years. Last year, they got £7.6 million. The government wants to stop this if they do not perform well.



Companies can get bonuses if they meet high standards. This helps improve the environment and customer service. The government wants better water services.



Bosses should get bonuses only for doing a good job. This is part of a plan to clean rivers, lakes, and seas in the UK.



The government has £104 billion to improve water pipes and treatment works, not for shareholders. This will make the water system better and stronger.



Different groups think this change is good. They hope it will help the environment and make sure water companies do their job well.
