

Tulip Siddiq, a UK MP, is accused of corruption by Bangladesh. She denies it. Muhammad Yunus refused to meet her, calling it a legal issue.



Yunus trusts Bangladesh's Anti-Corruption Commission. Siddiq says there's no proof against her and calls it a smear campaign.



Siddiq left her minister role. An investigation found no wrongdoing but noted her aunt's ties could harm her reputation.



Yunus met UK officials but not Siddiq or PM Starmer. Some protested against him. The UK is helping Bangladesh recover money from Siddiq's aunt's rule.
